It was great being with our Kenya friends and the Orphans. The schools were on a break while we were there which made it a great opportunity to interact with them. They all looked so good, thanks to our donors who give faithfully for their care.

Our missionary, Katlyn, got settled in well. We were able to install a stove/oven and other items needed for her to be safe and comfortable. She shipped 12 trunks from the USA through a shipping company. These trunks should arrive any day now. They are full of books and other supplies for the library we started. While there we built bookshelves and painted the entire Orphan wing hallway and doors in beautiful African colors. We have been selected by Kenya's major paint company to paint all of our buildings free of charge as their next community project. We thank our Kenya Board Member, Michael Wafula, for arranging this wonderful act of charity.

The Kenya Youth Shelter is doing well. Rev. Dancun Omondi and his wife Sylvia, are doing an outstanding job rescuing and providing food and shelter for the Street Kids in Kakamega. They presented Katlyn with a beautiful little dog. Our kids named him Rocky, but some call him "Ralphie."
